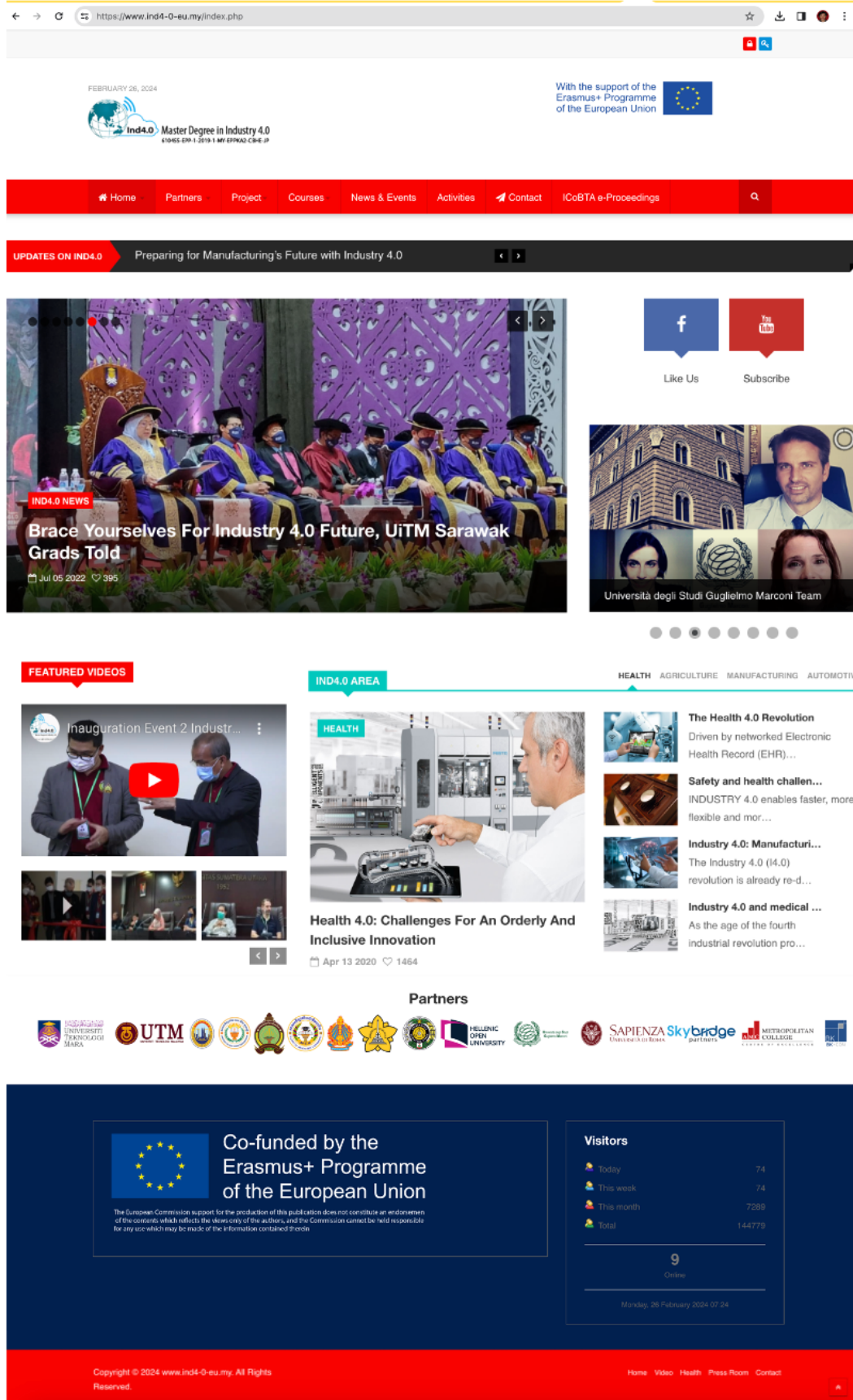


Figure 1: Home page of Ind4.0 website

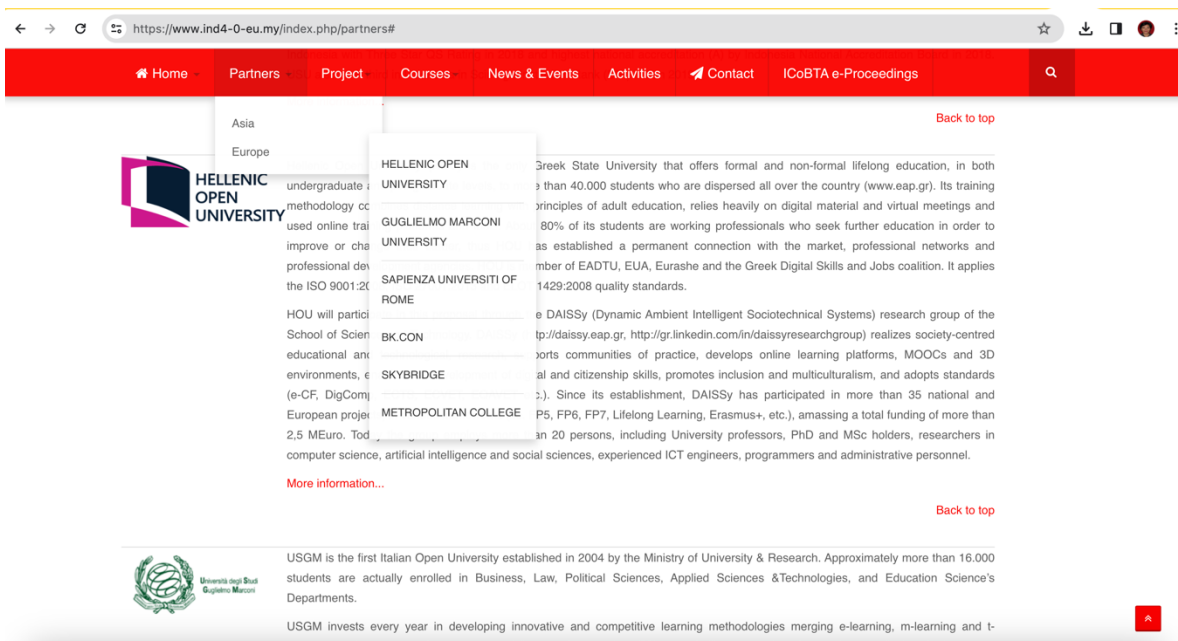
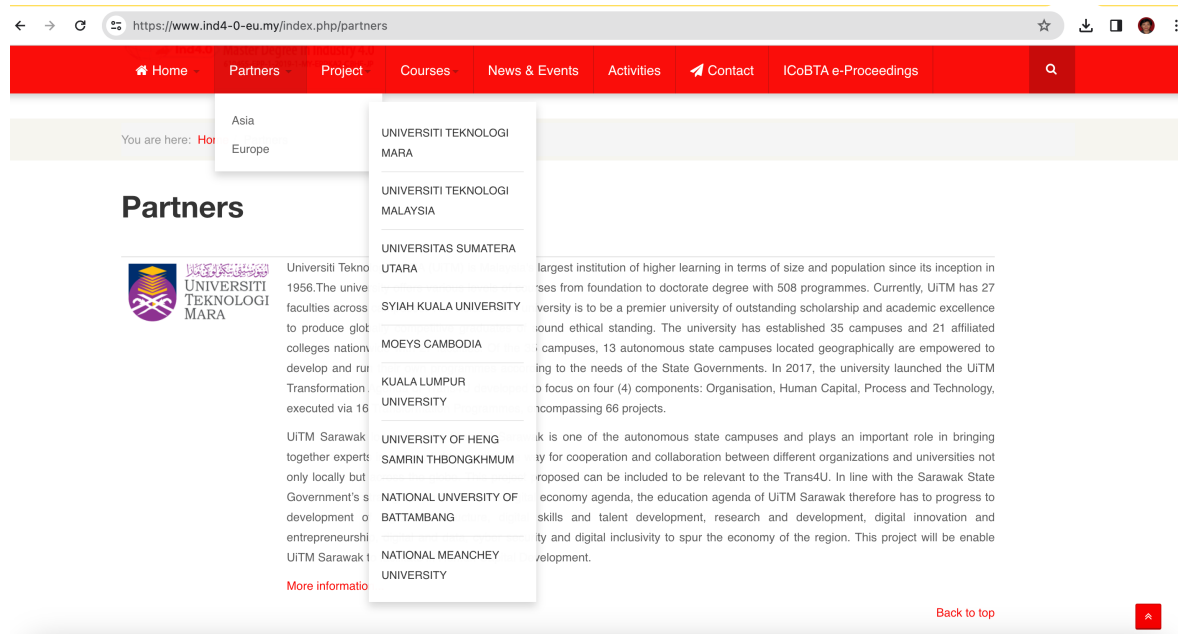


Figure 2: Information of partner institutions of the Ind4.0 Consortium

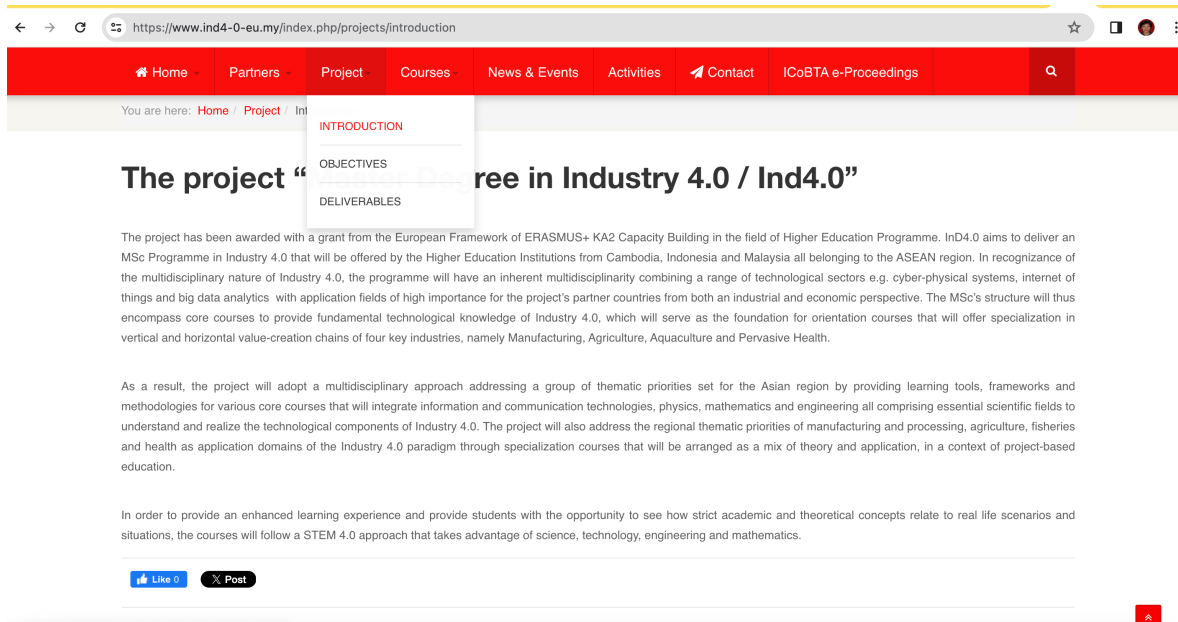


Figure 3: Introduction of the MSc in Ind4.0 project

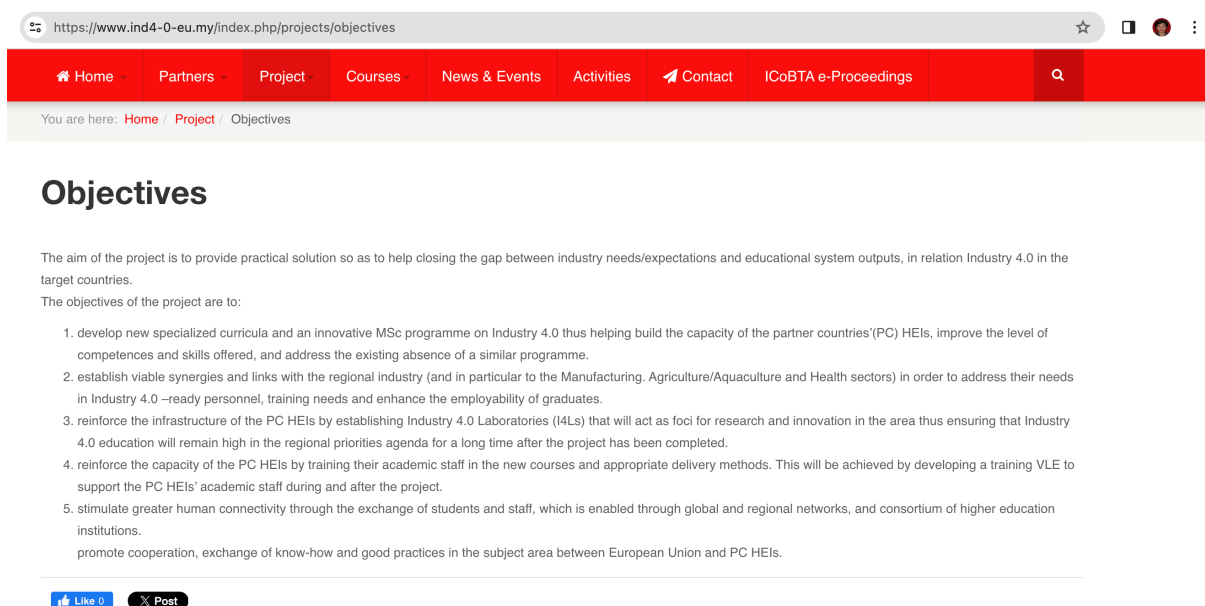


Figure 4: Objectives of Ind4.0 project

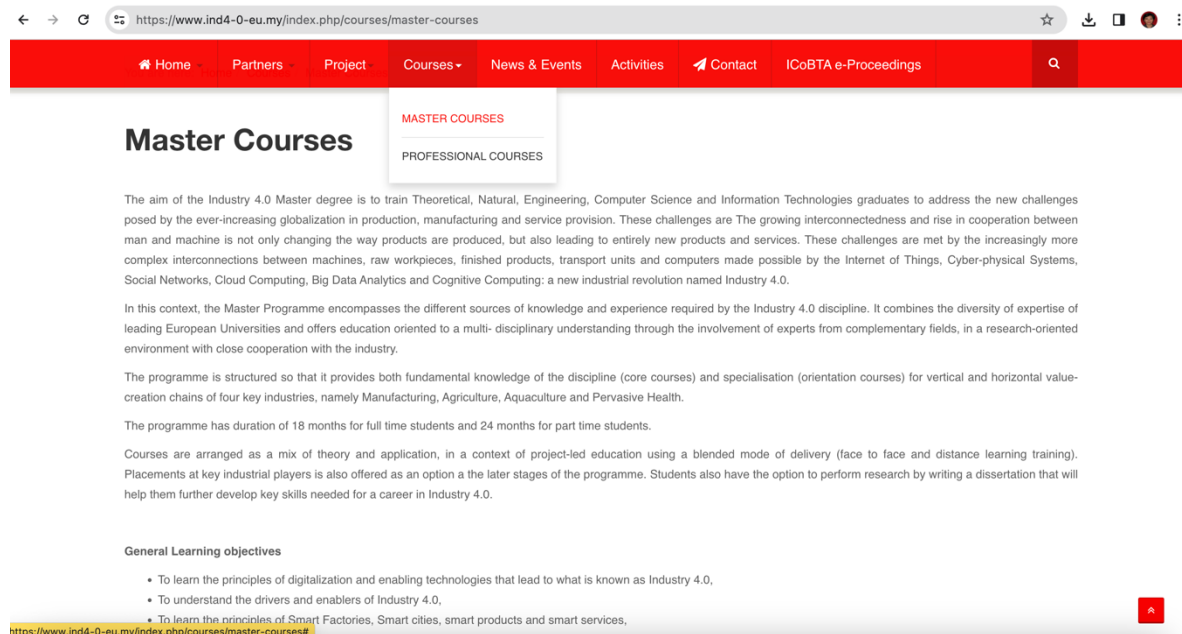


Figure 6: Description of the MSc Ind4.0 and Professional Courses

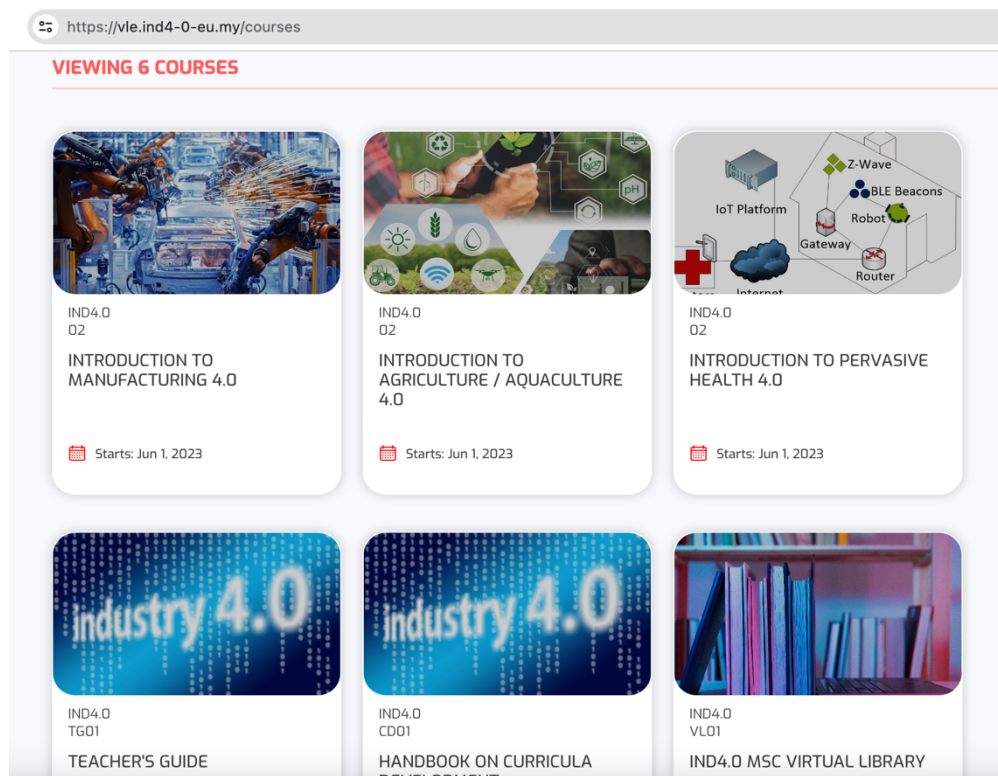


Figure 7: Learning materials and professional courses in the VLE platform

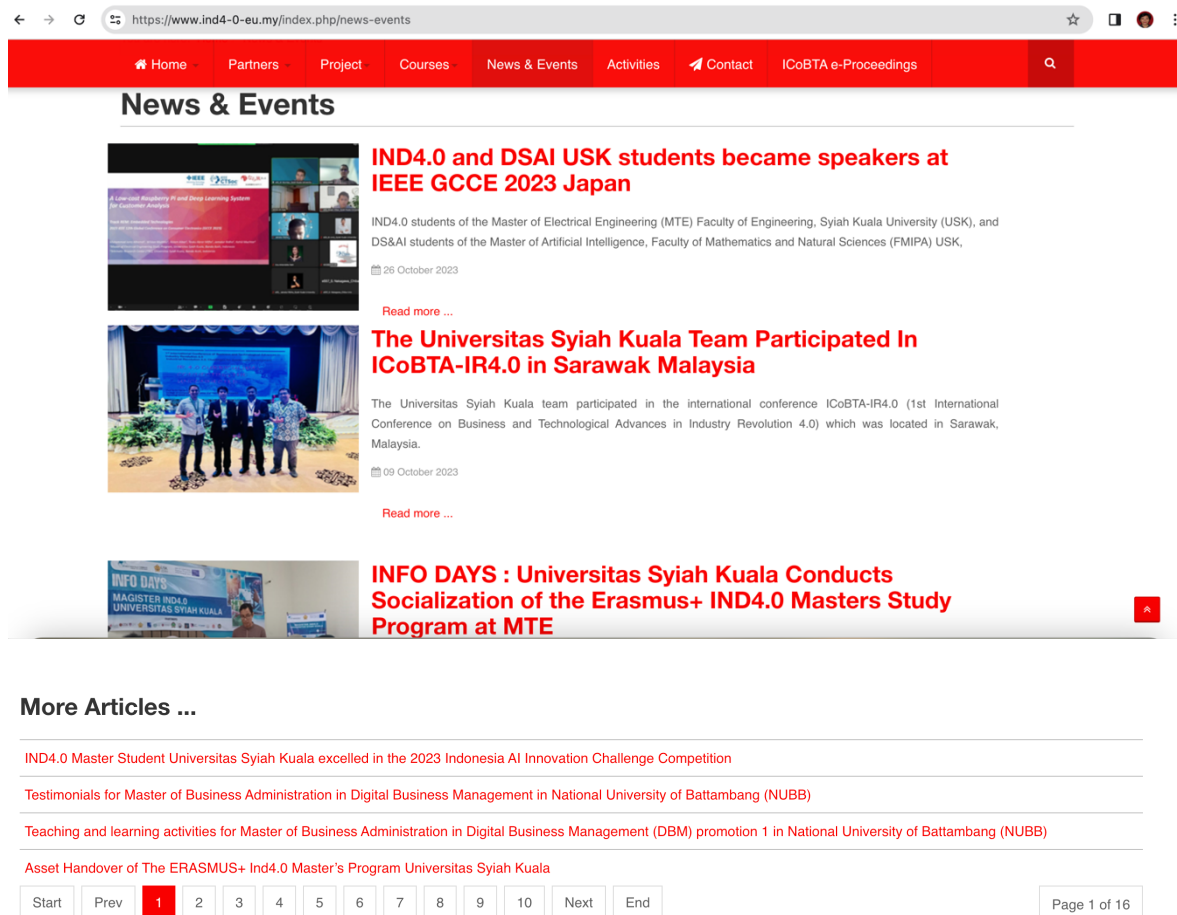


Figure 8: News and Events of the duration of the project

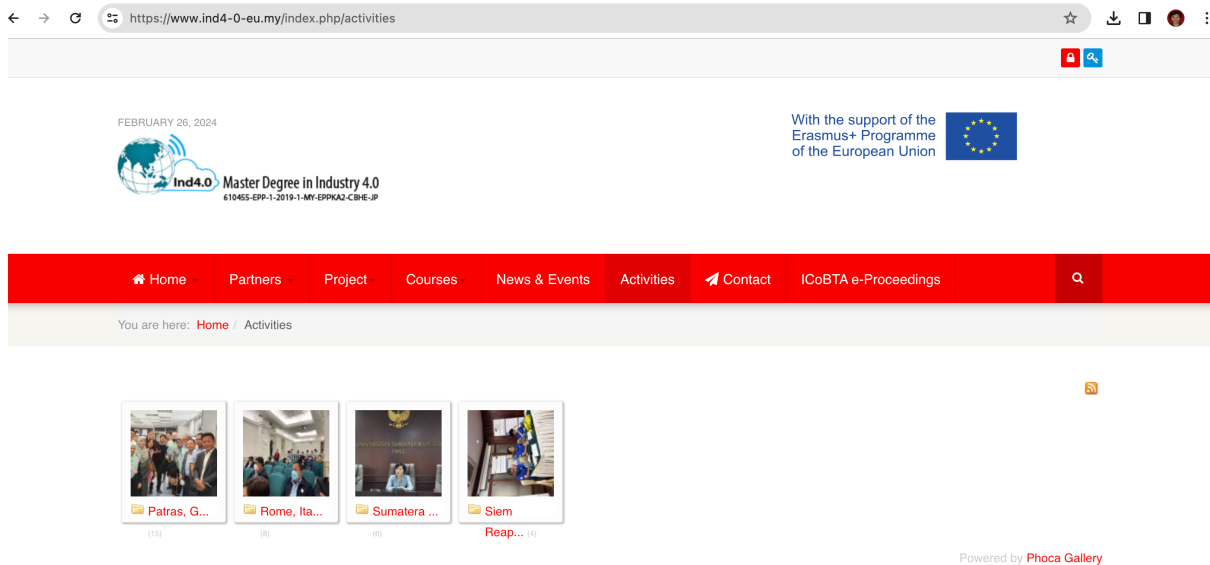


Figure 9: Gallery of photos of face-to-face major events of Ind4.0 project

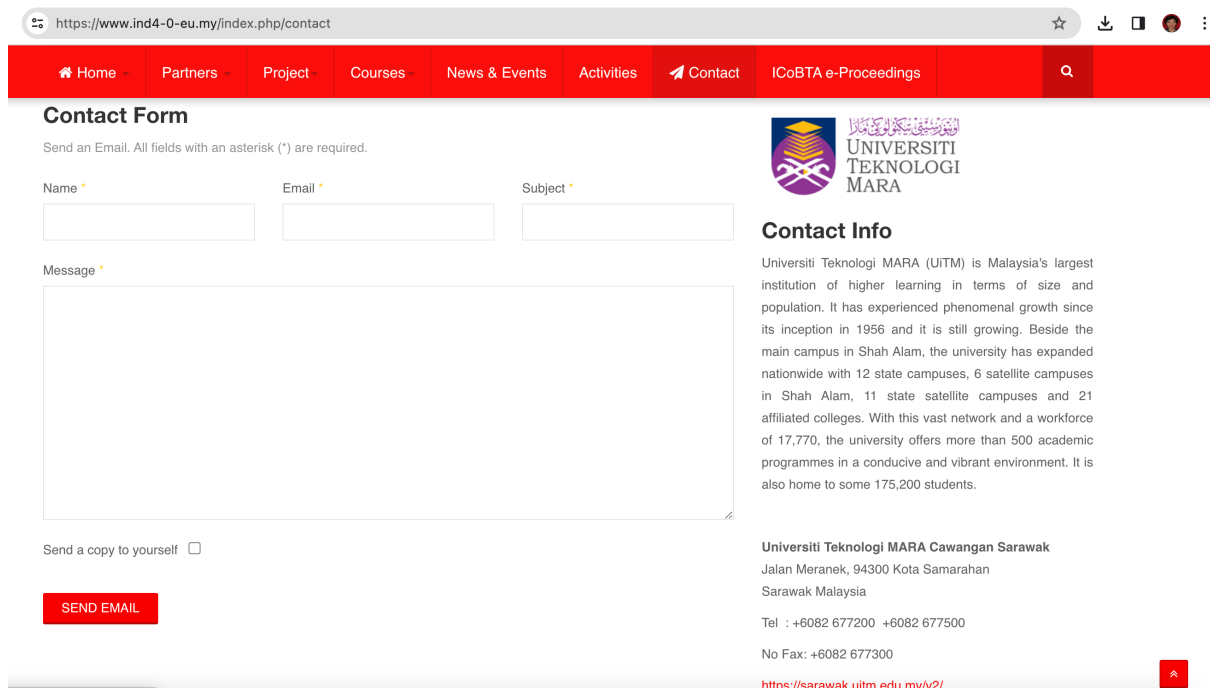


Figure 10: Contact page of the website

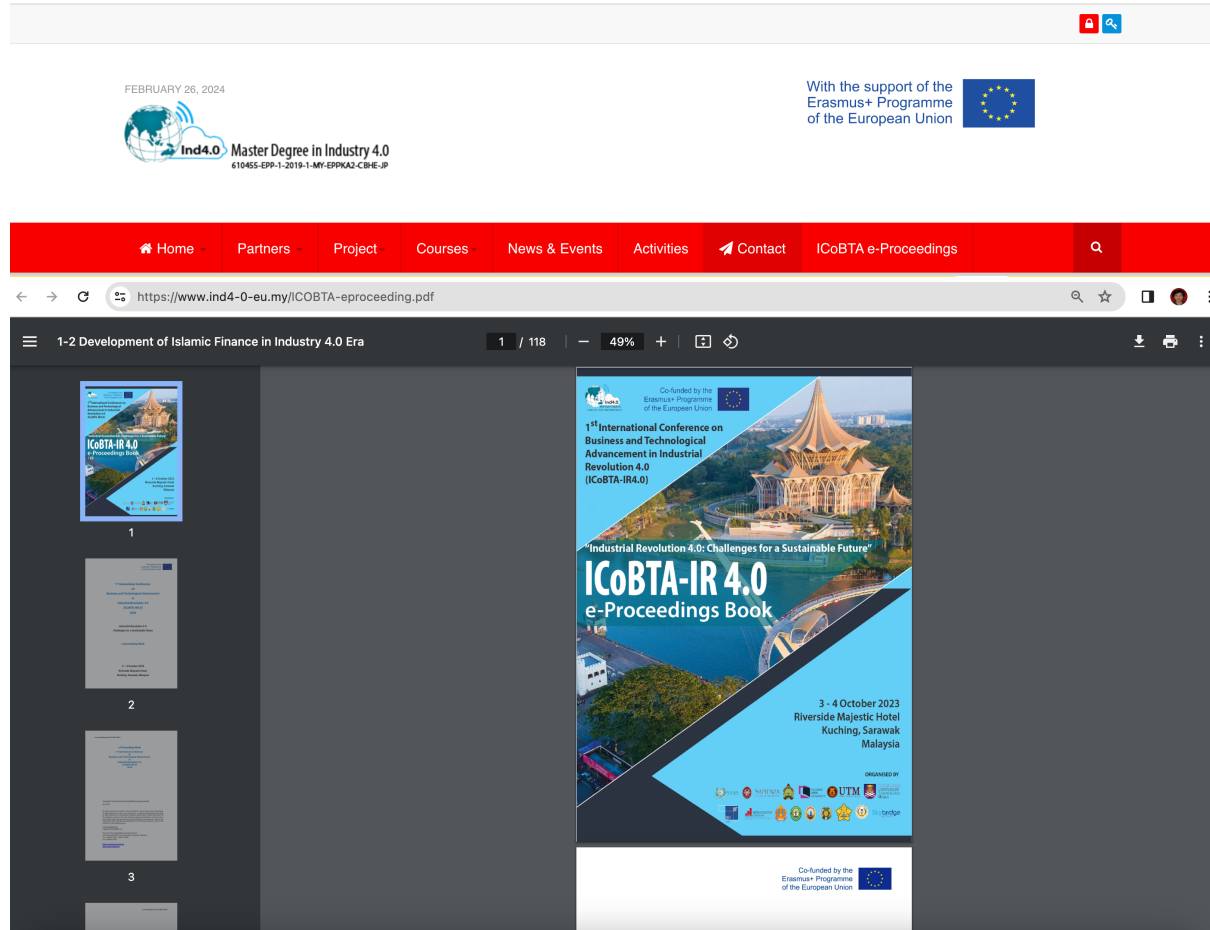
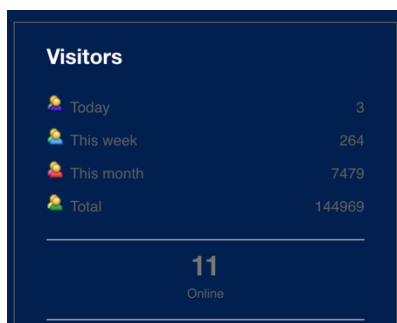


Figure 11: The e-proceedings of the International Conference of Business and Technological Advances in Industry Revolution 4.0 (ICoBTA-IR4.0)
